03. No separate insurance charges will be paid. The prices would be treated inclusive of insurance charges for covering the transit risk/loss/damage upto the consignees end.

04. The make and country of origin of the article offered may be stated

05. In case of clarification if any, must be asked for well before hand and not while submitting firm's quotations.

06. The quantity ordered may be increased or decreased by the indenter.

07. The date up to which quotation will be valid should be indicated.

08. Sealed quotations marked as "**QUOTATION vide NCB F.No .
