Sub: **Filling up of the post of Havaldar (Group 'C' Post) in Narcotics Control Bureau, Ministry of Home Affairs on deputation basis.**

The Narcotics Control Bureau, Ministry of Home Affairs intends to fill up 05 existing vacancies in the grade of Havaldar in the pay scale of Rs.5200-20200/- with Grade Pay of Rs.1800/- on deputation basis in the Bureau's HQrs and Zonal Units/Intelligence Cell at Mandi, Mumbai, Bangalore, Madurai, Chennai & Kolkata.

2. The number of vacancies are subject to increase or decrease. Applicants if selected are liable to be posted/transferred anywhere in India.
3. Application in the enclosed format of willing and eligible officers whose services can be spared, without delay, in the event of their selection may be forwarded through proper channel alongwith photocopies of ACRs for the last 5 years duly attested, Integrity Certificate and discipline/vigilance clearance certificate so as to reach the Deputy Director (Admn), Office of the Director General, Narcotics Control Bureau, West Block No.1, Wing No.5, R K Puram, New Delhi-110 066 within 45 days from the date of issue of this circular. The eligibility conditions are given here under :-

Havaldar (PB-1-Rs.5200-20200 + Grade Pay Rs.1800/-) (Group-C, Non-Gazetted, Non- Ministerial)

By deputation :

Personnel of the Central Government or the State Government/Union Territories Administration

- (i) Holding the post of Havaldar or Head Constable on regular basis in the parent cadre or department.

3. The terms and conditions of the deputation will be governed by the Department of Personnel & Training's OM No. 2/29/91-Estt. (Pay.II), dated 5.1.1994, as amended from time to time.

4. Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization or department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years.
