1. OPERATIONS

High Quantity Seizures by NCB (Zone wise)

Ahmedabad Zone

- On 21.07.2022, NCB, Ahmedabad Zonal Unit seized 391 grams of Mephedrone at CTM Toll Plaza, Surat, Gujarat. 03 persons were arrested.
- On 30.07.2022, NCB, Ahmedabad Zonal Unit seized 8.400 kg of Alprazolam and Rs. 1,08,000/- at Ankleshwar, Gujarat in the follow-up action of an earlier case of NCB, Ahmedabad. 03 persons were arrested.
- On 03.09.2022, NCB, Ahmedabad Zonal Unit seized 143 grams of Mephedrone at Ahmedabad, Gujarat. 01 person was arrested.
- On 05.09.2022, NCB, Ahmedabad Zonal Unit seized 9,444 tablets of Alprazolam at DHL Courier, Ahmedabad, Gujarat.

Case Study

Seizure of 8.400 Kgs of Alprazolam by Ahmedabad Zone

On the basis of a secret information, NCB Ahmedabad Zonal Unit busted a clandestine factory at GIDC, Vapi on 04.06.2022 and during the operation, approx. 75.490 Kg Nordazepam was seized and 04 persons were arrested. Further in a follow up action of the above seizure, a team of NCB Ahmedabad mounted surveillance and resultantly 03 more accused wereapprehended on 30\31.07.2022 and 8.4 Kg Alprazolam and 01 vehicle (four wheeler) were seized. Further, during a house search, one accused was arrested and Rs. 1,08,000/- cash was seized on 30.07.2022.

Bangalore Zone & Hyderabad Sub Zone

- On 25.07.2022, NCB, Bangalore Zonal Unit seized 1.302 kg of Cocaine at Kempegowda International Airport, Bangalore. 01 person was arrested.
- On 04.08.2022, NCB, Bangalore Zonal Unit seized 400 grams of Alprazolam Tablets (2000 Nos) at DHL Couriers, KIA, Bangalore. 01 person was arrested.
- On 20.09.2022, NCB, Bangalore Zonal Unit seized 4.902 kg of Pseudoephedrine at DHL Express India Pvt. Ltd, Yeshwantpur, Bangalore, Karnataka.
- On 21.09.2022, NCB, Bangalore Zonal Unit seized 4.901 kg of Methaqualone at DHL Express India Pvt. Ltd, Yeshwantpur, Bangalore, Karnataka.
- On 21.09.2022, NCB, Bangalore Zonal Unit seized 4.998 kg of Pseudoephedrine at DHL Express India Pvt. Ltd, Yeshwantpur, Bangalore, Karnataka.

Case Study

Seizure of 1.302 Kgs of Cocaine by Bangalore Zone

1. On 25.07.2022, on the basis of secret information, NCB Bangalore Zonal Unit seized 1.302 Kgs of Cocaine at International Arrival area, Kempegowda International Airport (KIA), Bengaluru which was concealed in 04 sheets inside the bottom of a bag carried by a bolivian lady who travelled by Ethopian Airline from Sao Paulo International Airport (Brazil) via Addis Ababa to Bangalore Airport. A case was registered and the lady was arrested on 26.07.2022 under the NDPS Act, 1985.





2. Seizure of 4.902 Kgs of Pseudoephedrine by Bangalore Zone

On 20.09.2022, on the basis of a secret information, the officers of NCB Bangalore Zonal Unit seized 4.902 Kgs of Pseudoephedrine (Controlled Substance Under provision of NDPS Act, 1985) at DHL Express India Pvt. Ltd, Yeshwanthpur, Bangalore from the suspicious parcel booked under airwaybill Nos. 2395150951. The contraband was concealed in 10 photo frames.







Chandigarh Zone, Amritsar Sub Zone & Mandi Sub Zone

• On 04.07.2022, NCB, Chandigarh Zonal Unit seized 112 grams of Heroin along with drug money Rs. 3,63,150/- from the house of accused at Malerkotla, Punjab. 01 person was arrested.

- On 05.07.2022, NCB, Amritsar Sub-Zone in coordination with BSF seized 320 grams of Heroin at BOP- Shamake, 116 Bn BSF, Ferozepur, Punjab. 03 persons were arrested.

Case Study

Seizure of 20 Kgs of Pseudoephedrine by Chennai Zone

On 17.08.2022, on the basis of a secret information, the NCB Chennai Zonal Unit intercepted a consignment of 10 boxes destined to New Zealand at ST Courier, Chennai. On examination of the 10 boxes, they were found to contain bed sheets. Further examination of the bed sheets resulted in the recovery and seizure of 20 kg Pseudoephedrine (controlled substance) concealed in the bed sheets. The consignor was found to be from Chennai and the consignment was destined to New Zealand.







Delhi Zone & Dehradun Sub Zone

 On 06.07.2022, NCB, Delhi Zonal Unit seized 4.650 kg of Pseudoephedrine at Aramex India Pvt. Ltd., Sector-28, Dwarka, New Delhi.

- On 13.07.2022, NCB, Delhi Zonal Unit seized 13,770 tablets of Alprazolam at DHL Exp. Pvt. Ltd., Rama Road, Kirti Nagar, New Delhi. 01 person was arrested.
- On 22.07.2022, NCB, Delhi Zonal Unit seized 512 grams of Methamphetamine at DHL, Exp. Pvt. Ltd., Rama Road, Kirti Nagar, New Delhi. 01 person was arrested.
- On 27.07.2022, NCB, Delhi Zonal Unit seized 1500 Nos. (500 grams) of Tramadol Tabs at Aramex India Pvt. Ltd., Dwarka, Sector-28, New Delhi.
- On 27.07.2022, NCB, Delhi Zonal Unit seized 300 Nos. (160 grams) of Tramadol Tabs at Aramex India Pvt. Ltd., Dwarka, Sector-28, New Delhi.
- On 27.07.2022, NCB, Delhi Zonal Unit seized 2,670 Nos. of Tramadol Tabs at Aramex India Pvt. Ltd., Dwarka, Sector-28, New Delhi.
- On 01.08.2022, NCB, Delhi Zonal Unit seized 4.867 kg of Amphetamine at DHL, Exp. Pvt. Ltd., Rama Road, Kirti Nagar, New Delhi.
- On 11.08.2022, NCB, Delhi Zonal Unit seized 745 grams of Heroin at NCB Delhi Zone Office in Controlled Delivery Operation.
- On 18.08.2022, NCB, Delhi Zonal Unit seized 174 grams of Amphetamine at Aramex India Pvt. Ltd, Dwarka, Sector- 28, New Delhi. In follow up action 283 grams of Amphetamine was seized at Amrit Seair Couriers Express Pvt. Ltd, Mahipalpur Ext., New Delhi on 20.08.2022. 03 persons were arrested.
- On 22.08.2022, NCB, Delhi Zonal Unit seized 900 grams (1,800 tablets) of Tramadol at DHL Exp. Pvt. Ltd, Rama Road, Kirti Nagar, New Delhi.
- On 23.08.2022, NCB, Delhi Zonal Unit seized 14,960 tablets of Zolpidem and 10,800 tablets of Tramadol at DTDC Exp. Pvt. Ltd, Telephone Exchange Road, Samalkha, New Delhi. 03 persons were arrested.
- On 04.09.2022, NCB, Delhi Zonal Unit seized 19.867 kg of Heroin at IGI Airport, New Delhi. 02 persons were arrested.
- On 14.09.2022, NCB, Delhi Zonal Unit seized 360 grams of Amphetamine at UPS Express Pvt. Ltd., DCSC Cargo Terminal- 3, IGI Airport, New Delhi.
- On 26.09.2022, NCB, Dehradun Sub-Zone seized 148 pieces of Buprenorphine, 1239 pieces Diazapam and 549 pieces of Psychotropic Injection at Rawli Mehdood, Haridwar, Uttarakhand. 03 persons were arrested.
- On 30.09.2022, NCB, Delhi Zonal Unit seized 2000 tablets of Tramadol at DHL Exp. Pvt. Ltd, Kirti Nagar, New Delhi.

1. Seizure of 4.650 Kgs of Pseudoephedrine by Delhi Zone

On 06.07.2022, on the basis of a secret information, a team of NCB Delhi Zonal Unit reached at Aramax pvt. Itd. Delhi Hub, Village Bamnoli, Sector- 28, Dwarka, New Delhi and intercepted a parcel bearing No.- 31670061371. As per Invoice/documents, the Parcel was booked by a person R/o Jamia Nagar, South Delhi and was destined to New Zealand. A total of 4.650 Kg white colour crystalline substance suspected to be Pseudoephedrine was seized from the said parcel. During the course of investigation of the case, it came to light that the above mentioned parcel was booked by a resident of Vyasarpadi, Chennai, Tamilnadu with the help of a fake ID. On 14.11.2022, the accused was arrested in this case and the fake document which was used as KYC in this case was also recovered from him. Investigation is in progress.

2. Seizure of 19.867 Kgs of Heroin by Delhi Zone

On 04.09.2022, on the basis of secret information a team of Delhi Zonal Unit reached at International Arrival Area, IGI Airport, New Delhi and intercept a Singapore national reaching Delhi by flight. During the search of his checked-in baggage, the team recovered 19.867 kgs Heroin. During preliminary investigation of the case, the accused revealed that he was to hand over the seized bags concealed with heroin at South West Inn Hotel, Dwarka, New Delhi on the direction of his handler who was at South Africa & who was also the supplier of seized drugs. Accordingly, a controlled delivery operation at South West Inn hotel, New Delhi was executed and a Nigerian national, who came to receive the bag, was arrested.

Guwahati Zone & Imphal Sub Zone

- On 08.07.2022, NCB, Guwahati Zonal Unit seized 1,728.900 kg of Ganja at Guwahati, Assam. 02 persons were arrested.
- On 11.07.2022, NCB, Guwahati Zonal Unit seized 297.520 kg of Ganja at NH-37, near Khanapara flyover, Guwahati. 01 person was arrested.



 On 26.09.2022, NCB, Guwahati Zonal Unit seized 517.080 kg of Ganja at NH-37 near Metro Hospital, Khanapara, Guwahati, Assam. 06 persons were arrested.

Seizure of 1728.900 Kgs of Ganja by Guwahati Zone

On 08.07.2022, NCB Guwahati Zonal Unit affected a seizure of 1728.900 Kgs Ganja from a truck bearing J&K registration number near Hindustan Tower, NH-37, Beltola, Guwahati, Assam, where two persons, belonging to Distt-Motihari (East Champaran), Bihar and Distt-Bhagalpur, Bihar respectively, have been arrested.

Another receiver was also arrested during a follow-up action by NCB Guwahati team at Naugacia, Bhagalpur, Bihar.



Indore Zone & Mandsaur Sub Zone

- On 03.07.2022, NCB, Indore Zonal Unit seized 140.750 kg of Ganja at Sehore, Madhya Pradesh. 02 persons were arrested.
- On 06.07.2022, NCB, Indore Zonal Unit seized 95.190 kg of Ganja at Sehore, Madhya Pradesh. 02 persons were arrested.



 On 12.07.2022, NCB, Indore Zonal Unit in coordination with NCB, Mandsaur Sub-Zone seized 123.080 kg of Ganja at Dhurwar Toll plaza, Shahdol, Madhya Pradesh. 04 persons were arrested.

- On 14.07.2022, NCB, Indore Zonal Unit seized 1276.470 kg of Ganja at Narsinghpur, Madhya Pradesh. 02 persons were arrested.
- On 25.07.2022, NCB, Indore Zonal Unit seized 260.350 kg of Ganja at Ujjain, Madhya Pradesh. 01 person was arrested.
- On 29.07.2022, NCB, Indore Zonal Unit seized 882.720 kg of Ganja at Bagwada Toll Plaza, Madhya Pradesh. 05 persons were arrested.
- On 19.08.2022, NCB, Indore Zonal Unit seized 206.470 kg of Ganja at Bhutani Toll Plaza, Sehor, Madhya Pradesh. 04 persons were arrested.
- On 29.09.2022, NCB, Mandsaur Sub-Zone seized 305.655 kg of Ganja at Kumhari Toll Plaza, Durg, Chhattisgarh. 02 persons were arrested.

Seizure of 1276.470 Kgs of Ganja by Indore Zone

On 14.07.2022, on the basis of specific information provided by UPSTF and developed by NCB Indore, NCB Zonal Unit Indore intercepted a truck bearing Rajasthan number at Bachai (Bakoli) Toll Plaza, Narsighpur (MP) and recovered 1276.470 Kgs Ganja and two persons R/O- Post-Baramai, Thana-Sadabad, Dist- Hathras, UP and R/O- Post-Saharakhurd, Thana- Iglash, Dist-Aligarh, UP respectively were arrested. The Illicit contraband was sourced from Sonepur (Odisha) and destined to Bharatpur (Raj).

During interrogation, both arrested persons revealed that they brought 1276.470 Kgs Ganja from another accused R/o, Teh.- Kantamal, Dist-Bodh (Odisha) and the same was to be delivered to a receiver R/o Bahaj, Dist-Bharatpur (Raj).

Further in a follow-up action, receiver of the seized drugs was arrested on 04.08.2022 at Police Station – Deeg, Dist- Bharatpur (Raj) and produced before NDPS Court Narsinghpur and presently he is also in judicial custody at Central jail Narsinghpur (MP).









Jammu Zone

- On 01.07.2022, NCB, Jammu Zonal Unit seized 9.700 kg of Hashish at Gumat Chowk, Jammu. 08 persons were arrested.
- On 26.07.2022, NCB, Jammu Zonal Unit seized 11,328 capsules of Spasmoproxyvon plus (Tramadol based) at M/S Jalandhar Body Builders, Samba (NH-44). 03 persons were arrested.
- On 22.08.2022, NCB, Jammu Zonal Unit seized 1,100 bottles of codeine based cough syrup at Transport Nagar, Narwal, Jammu. In follow-up action 720 bottles of codeine based cough syrup and 28,800 capsules of Tramadol were seized on 24.08.2022 at R.G. Complex, Paharganj, Delhi. 01 person was arrested.
- On 05.09.2022, NCB, Jammu Zonal Unit seized 4 kg of Hashish at Bus Stand, Jammu. 02 persons were arrested.

1. Seizure of 10 Kgs of Charas by Jammu Zone

On 01.07.2022, on the basis of a secret input developed, a team of NCB Jammu Zonal Unit had affected a seizure of 10 kgs of Charas in which whole network of the drug traffickers (08 persons) i.e main kingpin/supplier, his associates/carrier as well as receiver of the drug contraband were apprehended from nearby petrol pump at Gumat Chowk Jammu and 02 vehicles were also seized. The drug was concealed in the dicky of the car. The drug was originated from Srinagar and destined to Jammu for local consumption.



2. Seizure of 1820 bottles of Codeine Based Cough Syrup (CBCS) and 28800 nos. of Spasmoproxyvon capsules

On 22.08.2022, the team of NCB Jammu affected a courier based seizure of 1100 bottles of Codeine Based Cough Syrup (CBCS) at Jammu. During the follow up action in the case, 01 person was arrested by team of NCB from remote and militancy infested area of Budgam district on 23.08.2022. Thereafter, in another follow up action at Delhi, a team of NCB recovered &

seized 720 bottles of codeine based cough syrup and 28800 nos. Spasmoproxvon capsules on 24.08.2022.

Jodhpur Zone & Ajmer Sub Zone

- On 08.07.2022, NCB, Ajmer Sub-Zone seized 8.220 kg of Opium at NH-21, Bassi, Jaipur, Rajasthan. 01 person was arrested.
- On 16.07.2022, NCB, Jodhpur Zonal Unit seized 8.175 kg of Opium at Sheopura Ghata, Beawar, Rajasthan. 01 person was arrested.
- On 10.09.2022, NCB, Jodhpur Zonal Unit seized 307.150 kg of Poppy Straw at Kishorpura Toll Plaza, Hindoli, Rajasthan. 02 persons were arrested.



Case Study:

1. Seizure of 8.220 Kgs of Opium by Ajmer Sub Zone (Jodhpur Zone)

On 08.07.2022, NCB Sub Zonal Unit, Ajmer, seized 8.220 kgs Opium near Bassi Chak, NH-21, Jaipur- Dausa Road, Bassi, Dist- Jaipur, Rajasthan. The Opium was seized from a back pack carried by a person travelling from Imphal, (Manipur) to Barmer, (Rajasthan) by a private bus. One person r/o-Merta City, Dist.- Nagaur, Rajasthan was also arrested on 08.07.2022 in connection with this case.

In the further follow up, one more person R/o Didwana, Dist.-Nagaur, Rajasthan was also arrested on 21.10.2022.



2. Seizure of 8.175 Kgs of Opium by Jodhpur Zone

On 16.07.2022, on the basis of a specific information, a team of NCB Zonal Unit Jodhpur proceeded to Shivpura Ghata, Beawar, district Ajmer (Raj), where one person who was driving Honda Shine motor cycle was identified and during search, 03 packets of Opium (6.625 kgs) were recovered from his motorcycle. Seizure proceedings were carried out at premises of PS- Beawar Sadar, District Ajmer (Further during house search two packets containing opium were also seized weighing 1.550 kg. Further, the accused was arrested and after production in Hon'ble court, he was sent to Sub jail, Beawar.



Kolkata Zone & Bhubaneswar Sub Zone

- On 16.07.2022, NCB, Bhubaneshwar Sub-Zone seized 738 kg of Ganja at Nandankanan, Bhubaneshwar, Orissa. 02 persons were arrested.
- On 31.07.2022, NCB, Bhubaneswar Sub-Zone seized 205.200 kg of Ganja at Aginia Square, Bhubaneswar, Odisha. 04 persons were arrested.
- From 13.08.2022 to 25.08.2022, NCB, Kolkata Zonal Unit seized a total of 497 grams of Cocaine from a Brazilian national who was apprehended at Kolkata Airport on 12.08.2022.
- On 06-07.09.2022, NCB, Bhubaneswar Sub-Zone seized 21 kg of Ganja at Kakamaha, Katringiya, Odisha. 04 persons were arrested.
- On 07.09.2022, NCB, Kolkata Zonal Unit seized 113.930 kg of Poppy Straw at Baja Kadamthal Ghat, Eastern Road, Kolkata and in follow-up action seized 350 grams of Opium at Barabazar, Kolkata. 03 persons were arrested.
- On 07.09.2022, NCB, Kolkata Zonal Unit in coordination with BSF seized 450 bottles of codeine based cough syrup. 03 persons were arrested.

Lucknow Zone

- On 04.07.2022, NCB, Lucknow Zonal Unit seized 145 kg of Ganja at Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh. 01 person was arrested.
- On 07.07.2022, NCB, Lucknow Zonal Unit seized 37.400 kg of Ganja at Vindhyachal, Mirzapur, UP. 02 persons were arrested.

District Shravasti UP from the possession of one Nepali citizen R/o vill Pipharawa PS Bhagwanpur, District - Banke, Nepal.

Interrogations revealed that the seized Charas was originated at Banke area of



Nepal and it was to be supplied to a person R/o Baharaich, U.P.

NCB Lucknow in tandem with SSB has made significant efforts in the field of Drug Law Enforcement at the Indo-Nepal bordering region.

3. Seizure of 10.8 Kg of Hashish on 02.09.2022 by Lucknow Zone

On 02.09.2022, acting upon specific information, NCB Lucknow Zonal Unit affected a seizure of 10.8 Kg of Charas from a bus bearing Madhya Pradesh Regn. number from the possession of one person R/o East Champaran, Bihar at Purvanchal Expressway, Lucknow Mod, Gosaiganj, U.P.

During the interrogation, it was revealed that the drug was originated from Gorakhpur and it was destined for Bhopal, M.P.



Case Study:

Seizure of 3.2 Kgs of Cocaine by Mumbai Zone

On 26.09.2022, acting on a specific information, NCB Zonal Unit Mumbai affected a seizure of 3.2 Kg of Cocaine at Chhattrpati Shivaji Maharaja International Airport, Mumbai at Terminal-2 from the possession of a Bolivian national lady who was placed under arrest. The drug was concealed in a black color trolley bag by placing them inside two cavities.

Black cocaine is a mixture of regular cocaine base or cocaine hydrochloride with various other substances such as pigments and dyes, e.g. charcoal are

added to camouflage the typical appearance and to make the mixture undetectable by drug sniffing dogs (activated carbon may sufficiently absorb trace odour).

On follow up action a Nigerian national who was the suspected receiver of the contraband was also apprehended and placed under arrest on 30.09.2022.

Destruction of illicit opium poppy/cannabis cultivation (July-September, 2022)

The extent of illicit cultivation of opium poppy as well as of cannabis cannot be exactly quantified but eradications undertaken by law enforcement agencies are indicative of the areas prone to such cultivation. The Government of India has undertaken the satellite imaging of such illicit cultivation and results from this enable a more focused approach for eradication of the illicit crop.

During July-September, 2022, illicit cultivation of opium poppy and cannabis was found in the states of Manipur, Jammu & Kashmir, Gujarat and Himachal Pradesh.

DISPOSAL OF DRUGS

Drug Disposal

The Hon'ble Supreme Court in 2016 in the matter 'Union of India v/s Mohanlal & Anr (Crl. Appeal 652/2012)' had taken cognizance of the fact that a lot of seized contraband is being kept with the Central and State agencies and that the efforts taken towards the destruction of such contraband are not adequate. The Court has delivered a judgment on these aspects of NDPS law and observed that Section 52 A requires that no sooner the seizure is done, the contraband is to be forwarded to the officer in charge of a police station or the officer empowered. Such an officer is then duty bound to approach the Magistrate for drawing samples and getting them certified. The Court passed directions that the agencies will store the seized contraband as per the directions issued in NCB Standing order 1/89. The Court also ordered that the storage facilities will be upgraded at the State and Central level and will be placed under the overall supervision of a gazetted officer and put under double lock system and etc. The Court has also observed that periodical inspection of the storage facilities is also missing.

Disposal of seized drugs was also carried out at various locations, which was virtually launched by the Hon'ble Union Home Minister. A total of more than 30,000 Kgs of drugs was destroyed during the special campaign which was carried out during the organization of National Conference on "Drug Trafficking & National Security" at Chandigarh on 30-31 July, 2022.



Suggestions / Directions of Hon'ble Union Home Minister during National Conference on "Drug Trafficking & National Security" on 30-31 July, 2022 at Chandigarh:

- 1. The dirty money that comes from the business of drugs is eventually used for anti-national activities. For social progress and to strengthen the economy of the country, a policy of zero tolerance against drugs smuggling should be adopted.
- 2. The Ministry of Social Justice and the Ministry of Health should join hands for children who have come under influence of drug addiction. Ministry of Education & Ministry of Social Welfare to ensure that the younger generation does not get addicted to drugs.
- 3. The Ministry of Home Affairs and other State Police will have to work together to stop supply of money which is being used in the illegal trade of drugs. The Ministry of Home Affairs will have to take very strict steps to put a stop to it. Whatsoever agencies are working in the curbing of narcotics, all those agencies shall not work separately. They need to work together in coordination with each other, complementing each other; only then maximum results can be achieved.
- 4. Agencies related to police and narcotics of Drugs affected states get maximum benefit by using NCORD portal. Data on all those crimes of NDPS authorized agencies and NCB is available in NIDAAN Dashboard. Also practice and use the Diagnostics Dashboard. Work is also being done in the direction of not requiring subject experts and contraband testers to be brought from far to a seizure site in order to detect and identify narcotics.
- 5. In this direction we need to become self-reliant. Empowerment of all Central, State or other agencies fighting against Narcotics is needed.
- 6. Providing agencies with world-wide best practices, best equipment and facilities and working at a fast pace on a comprehensive de-addiction awareness campaign.
- 7. Seizure of narcotics, making the youth free from drug addiction and creating awareness among the youth about the ill effects of drugs will have to work in common on all these three points.
- 8. NCORD is a four-tier committee, the central level, the state level and the district level to ultimately bring the results. The agency is at the district level which has to deal with the problem first. Therefore, the meeting of the district level committee should be done smoothly. If the officers of the State Level Committee engage three hours in a week and one day in a month for the work related to Narcotics, then this campaign will move forward very fast.

- 9. Anti-Narcotics Drugs Task Force has been constituted by 21 states so far. The remaining states should also constitute a task force soon.
- 10. Dark web and Crypto currency trading are intertwined. A Task Force on Dark Web and Crypto currencies has been constituted by the Ministry of Home Affairs. Drug trafficking and crypto currency is becoming synonymous. To solve these problems, technology experts will have to be added.
- 11. A MoU has been signed between NCB and National University of Forensic Sciences. Under this agreement, if any state wants to set up a model forensic lab, then the National Forensic Science University and NCB will guide them.
- 12. Due to being a border state, the problem of drugs is more serious in the state of Punjab, so more efforts will have to be made there. If the Punjab Government provides land and infrastructure to the Central Government, Forensic lab and NCB centre will be opened in Amritsar by the Government of India and will provide training. An initiative by NCB in association with Bhaskaracharya Centre (BISAG-N) for identification of cultivation of illegal drugs.
- 13. A joint effort is being made which a technology is being developed through which Satellite images can identify the area of cultivation of illegal drugs.
- 14. Affected states can get help in this regard by contacting Bhaskaracharya Centre. The Ministry of Home Affairs, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare and the Ministry of Chemicals and Fertilizers should re-identify such drugs which can be banned by constituting an inter-ministerial committee for such medicines which are used for drug as well as intoxication. Also identify drugs that are medically essential that cannot be banned. State government also Proceed with rigor.
- 15. In case of seizure of large quantities of drugs, if the case is outside the state limits, then the concerned state will hand over the matter to the NCB and if the case goes beyond the country's borders, then to the NIA.
- 16. The states which are the gateway of Drugs and in which the drug trade remains a serious problem, those states will have to develop a system of mutual coordination.

3. CAPACITY BUILDING

NCB has been regularly organizing training programmes s to enhance and sharpen the specialized skills of drug law enforcement personnel. During July to September, 2022, NCB organized 49 training courses and a total of 3,461 personnel working in various Central / State agencies were trained.

During this period, NCB conducted 70 Awareness Programmes at various locations in India. A total of 10,034 persons participated in the said

programmes.



अपने बचपन के दौर से, उन यादों से या फिर आज भी जब कभी उन गलियों की गिनती वाले हालात से गुजरता हूँ तो वहाँ की हरियाली, वहाँ के जंगल, खुली हवाएँ, दूर-दूर तक लहलहाती फसलें, शांत वातावरण, वहाँ की निदयों को महसूस करने लगता हूँ। फिर थोड़ी देर बाद मुझे लगता है मैं किसी नयी दुनियाँ में आ गया हूँ, मैं वहीं रुक जाना चाहता हूँ वहाँ से कभी दूर नहीं जाना चाहता हूँ।

अपनी स्मृतियों में खोकर मैं अचानक घास-फूस के घरों में रहने वाले लोगों को देखता हूँ, जिनकी झोंपड़ियों में अब भी लाइट नहीं है, आज तक वहाँ 10 किलोमीटर के क्षेत्र में कोई प्राथमिक चिकित्सा केंद्र नहीं है, कोई कान्वेंट स्कूल नहीं है, कोई कल-कारखाने नहीं है, कोई जल-कल व्यस्था नहीं है, सिर्फ खेती, दैनिक मजदूरी या फिर साईकिल पर फेरी लगाने वाले लोगों का हूज़ूम है।

वहाँ आज भी छोटी-छोटी मूलभूत सुविधाओं का अभाव है लेकिन शराब है, भांग हैं, नशे की गोलियाँ हैं, सीमा पर तस्करी है, अपराध है, भ्रष्टाचार है। वहाँ वापस जाने का मन तो बहुत करता है लेकिन मैं यह भी चाहता हूँ कि मेरे बच्चों को अच्छी शिक्षा मिले, अच्छा संस्कार और अच्छा वातावरण मिले, पढ़ने की सुविधा मिले, लाइट मिले, इंटरनेट मिले, मेरे परिवार, मेरे वृद्ध माता-पिता को अच्छी स्वास्थ्य सेवाओं के लिए अच्छा अस्पताल मिले और इन सभी के लिए पैसों की जरूरत पड़ती है, तभी मेरे मन में स्वतः दो विकल्प आने लगते हैं। पुनः मुझसे पूछते हैं इन दोनों में से किसी एक को चुन लो - पैसा या फिर जिन्दगी।

आज मैं अपने देश की राजधानी में हूँ जो अपने आधुनिक चमक-दमक से भरपूर रंग बिखेरे हुए है, लेकिन किसी के पास समय नहीं है, लोग पिक्षयों की तरह एक घोंसले में रहते हैं दाना चुगने के लिए अपने घोंसलों से बाहर निकलते हैं और कुछ पक्षी शाम को वापस अपने घोंसले में घुस जाते हैं तो कुछ पक्षी रात्रिचर की तरह रात में दाना-पानी की तलाश में अपने घोसलों से बाहर निकल पड़ते हैं।

जिस तरह पिक्षयों और जानवरों में हम आम लोग कोई खास भेद नहीं कर पाते हैं, कुछ वैसे ही, शहरों में मुझे इंसानों की स्वार्थ भरी जिंदगी में अच्छे बुरे इंसान का भेद करना बहुत मुश्किल है। बहुत पहले मैनें हिरवंश सहाय की पंक्तियों को पढा था कि "यही पशु-प्रवृत्ति है कि आप, आप ही चरे" यहाँ मैं वह सब-कुछ चिरतार्थ होते हुए देख पा रहा हूँ।

अधिकांशतः पाता हूँ कि पुरूष क्या और क्या औरतें दोनों में ही पैसा कमाने का इतनी होड़ है कि खाने की गुणवत्ता को कोई महत्ता नहीं है, इन बड़े शहरों में करोड़ों रुपये का सिर्फ ब्रेड और पकौड़ों का व्यापार चल रहा है क्योंकि अधिकतर औरतें माँ बनकर खाने की गुणवत्ता को उतना तवज्जो नहीं देना चाहती हैं जितना तवज्जो वो पैसे कमाकर बने बनाए खाने को खरीदकर अपने बच्चों को खाना देने में करतीं हैं। कुछ माँओं के अन्दर जिम्मेदारियों का बोध तो स्पष्ट रुप से दिखता है लेकिन वो ममता,वो स्नेह छलकता हुआ नहीं दिखता शायद व्यस्तता के कारण ,जो मेरी माँ के मन में मेरे खाने,मेरे जगने,मेरे सोने, मेरे चलने, मेरे गिरने और मेरे उठने, मेरे रोने, मेरे हँसने, मेरे पढ़ने, मेरे लड़ने पर मैनें अपने माँ के अंदर आभास किया था।
