- G.S.R. 14.— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Additional Director in the Narcotics Control Bureau, under the Ministry of Home Affairs, namely:-
- 1. Short title and commencement. (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Home Affairs, Narcotics Control Bureau, Additional Director (Group 'A' Post) Recruitment Rules, 2024.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Number of post, classification and level in pay matrix.—The number of the said post, its classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
- 3. Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc.— The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.
- Disqualification. No person,—
 - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
 - (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- 5. Power to relax.— Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- 6. Saving. Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation in age-limit, and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Schedule Tribes, the Other Backward Classes, the Exservicemen and other special category of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard

Officers of the Central Government or the State Governments or Union territory Administrations,-(a) (i) holding analogous post on a regular basis in the parent cadre or Department; or (ii) with five year's service rendered after appointment to the post on a regular basis in level- 12 in the pay matrix (Rs. 78800-209200) or equivalent in the parent cadre or department; and (b) possessing the following educational qualifications and experience, namely:-(i) Bachelor's degree from a recognised University or (ii) Ten years' experience in the enforcement of regulatory laws and collection of intelligence relating Desirable: Four years' experience in the investigation of criminal offences including economic offences. Note 1: The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, the deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion. Note 2: The period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation or department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not to exceed five years.

Note 3: The age-limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding fifty-six years on the closing date of

receipt of applications.
