- G.S.R. 13.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Ministry of Home Affairs (Narcotics Control Bureau), Assistant Director Group 'A' post, Recruitment Rules, 2010, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the Group 'A' post in the Narcotics Control Bureau under the Ministry of Home Affairs, namely:-
- 1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Home Affairs, Narcotics Control Bureau, Assistant Director, Group 'A' post, Recruitment Rules, 2024.
  - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Number of post, classification and level in pay matrix.— The number of post, its classification and level in pay matrix attached thereto, shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
- 3. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications, etc.— The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matter relating thereto, shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.
- 4. Disqualification.— No person,—
  - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or



(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- 5. **Power to relax.** Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- 6. Saving.— Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and Other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Promotion:  Superintendent in the level-08 (Rs. 47600-151100) in the pay matrix with eight years of regular service in the grade and successfully undergone four weeks mandatory prepromotional training, for which training programme to be prepared and imparted by the Narcotics Control Bureau or from any other reputed institute approved by Narcotics Control Bureau.  Note 1The eligibility service shall continue to be six years for the officers holding the post of Superintendent on regular basis on the date of notification of the rules. Note 2.- Where juniors who have completed their qualifying or eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service or two years, whichever is less, and have successfully completed their probation period for promotion to the next higher grade along with their juniors who have already completed such qualifying or eligibility service.

## Deputation:-

Officers under the Central Government or the State Government or Union territories:

- (a) (i) holding analogous posts on regular basis in the parent cadre or department; or
- (ii) with five years regular service after appointment thereto on a regular basis in posts in the level-10 (Rs. 56100-177500) in the pay matrix or equivalent in the parent cadre or department; and
- (b) possessing the following educational qualifications and experience, namely:-
  - bachelors' degree from a recognised University or Institute;
  - five years' experience in enforcement of regulatory laws and collection of intelligence relating thereto;

Desirable:-

Experience of one year in investigation and supervision in any of the following fields:-

- Drug related offences or Enforcement of criminal laws,
- (ii) Financial investigation,
- (iii) Money laundering;
- (iv) Economic Frauds or Offences.

Note 1.-The Departmental Officers in the feeder grade who are in the direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, the deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

Note 2.-Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post heid immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation or department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not to exceed four years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall not be exceeding fifty six years on the closing date of receipt of application.
