New Delhi, the 16th June, 2023

G.S.R. 461(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Ministry of Home Affairs, Narcotics Control Bureau, Staff Car Driver (Group 'C' Posts) Recruitment Rules, 2015, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Staff Car Driver (Group 'C' Posts) in the Ministry of Home Affairs, Narcotics Control Bureau, namely:—

1. **Short title and commencement.**— (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Home Affairs, Narcotics Control Bureau, Staff Car Driver (Group 'C', Non Gazetted Post) Recruitment Rules, 2023.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

Application.— These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column (1) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

2. **Number of posts, classification and level in the pay matrix.**— The number of the posts, their classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the afore-said Schedule.

3. **Method of recruitment, age-limit and other qualifications, etc.**— The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto, shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. **Disqualification.**— No person,—

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. **Power to relax.**— Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. **Saving.**— Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Schedule Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Deputation or Absorption : From amongst the regular Dispatch Rider (Group C) and Group C employees in level-1(Rs. 18000-56900) in the pay matrix in Narcotics Control Bureau who possess valid Driving License for Motor Cars on the basis of a Driving Test to assess the competence to drive Motor Cars failing which from officials holding the post of Dispatch Rider on regular basis or regular Group C employees in in the level -1(Rs. 18000-56900) in the pay matrix in other Ministries of the Central Government who fulfill the necessary qualifications as mentioned in column (7). 2.
