NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 17th May, 2018

- G.S.R. 481(E).— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules to amend the Ministry of Home Affairs, Narcotics Control Bureau, Lower Division Clerk (Group 'C' Non Gazetted, Ministerial posts) Recruitment Rule, 2013 namely:-
- 1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Home Affairs, Narcotics Control Bureau, Lower Division Clerk Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2018.
 - (2) They shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. In the Ministry of Home Affairs, Narcotics Control Bureau, Lower Division Clerk (Group 'C' Non Gazetted, Ministerial posts) Recruitment Rule, 2013 (herein after referred to as the said rules), for rule 2, the following rule shall be substituted, namely:-
 - "2. Number of posts, classification and level in the pay matrix.-The number of posts, its classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules."
- 3. In the said rules, in the Schedule,-
 - (A) in column (4), for the heading and the entries relating thereto, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

"Level in the pay matrix

- (B) in column (10),-
 - (i) for the words, letters and figures "Grade Pay of Rs.1800", the words, figures and letters "level-1 in the pay matrix (Rs. 18000-56900)" shall be substituted;
 - (ii) for the words, letters and figures "Grade pay of Rs. 1800", the words, figures and letters "level-1 in the pay matrix (Rs. 18000-56900)" shall be substituted;
- (C) in column (11), under the sub-heading "Promotion" for the words, letters and figures "Grade Pay of Rs. 1800", the words, figures and letters "level-1 in the pay matrix (Rs. 18000-56900)" shall be substituted.

MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (Narcotics Control Bureau) NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 25th February, 2013

GS.R. 162(E).— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Ministry of Home Affairs (Narcotics Control Burcau) Group 'C' and Group 'D' posts, Recruitment Rules, 2007, in so far as it relates to the post of Lower Division Clerk, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Central Government hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Lower Division Clerk in the Narcotics Control Bureay under the Ministry of Home Affairs, namely:—

- 1. Short title and Commencement.— (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Home Affairs, Narcotics Control Bureau, Lower Division Clerk (Group 'C' Non Gazetted, Ministerial posts), Recruitment Rules, 2013.
 - (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Number of post, classification and pay band and grade pay or pay scale.—
 The number of the said posts, their classification and the pay band and grade pay or pay scale attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
- 3. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications, etc. The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto, shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.

Disqualification. No person,

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts;

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- 5. Power to relax.— Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- 6. Saving. Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
