NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 17th May, 2018

G.S.R. 478(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules to amend the Ministry of Home Affairs, Narcotics Control Bureau, Senior Private Secretary (Group 'B' posts) Recruitment Rule, 2012 namely:-

1. (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Home Affairs, Narcotics Control Bureau, Senior Private Secretary (Group 'B' posts) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2018.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Ministry of Home Affairs, Narcotics Control Bureau, Senior Private Secretary (Group 'B' posts) Recruitment Rules, 2012 (hereinafter referred to as the said rules), for rule 2, the following rule shall be substituted, namely:-

“2. Number of post, classification and level in the pay matrix,- The number of post, its classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto, shall be as specified in column(2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.”.

3. In the said rules, in the Schedule,-

(A) In column (4), for the heading and the entries relating thereto, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“Level in the pay matrix

Level -8 (Rs.47600-151100/-);

(B) In column (11):-

- under sub-heading “Promotion”, for the words, figures and letters “Pay Band-2 in the Pay Scale of Rs. 9300-34800 with Grade Pay of Rs. 4600”, the words, figures and letters “Level-7 (Rs.44900-142400/-)” shall be substituted;
- under Sub-heading “Deputation”, in item (ii), for the words, figures and letters “Pay Band-2 in the Pay Scale of Rs. 9300-34800/- with Grade Pay of Rs. 4600”, the words, figures and letters “Level-7 (Rs. 44900-142400/-)” shall be substituted.

New Delhi, the 22nd August, 2012

G.S.R. 645(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Ministry of Home Affairs, Narcotics Control Bureau, (Senior Private Secretary) Recruitment Rules, 2008, except as respects and things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Central Government hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Senior Private Secretary, in the Narcotics Control Bureau, Ministry of Home Affairs, namely:-

1. **Short title and commencement** – (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Home Affairs, Narcotics Control Bureau, Senior Private Secretary (Group 'B', posts), Recruitment Rules, 2012.
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. **Number of post, classification and pay band and grade pay or pay scale:-** The number of the said post, its classification and the pay band and grade pay or pay scale attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. **Method of Recruitment, age limit and other qualifications, etc.-** The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto, shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.

4. **Disqualification:-** No person

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person.

Shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts.

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. **Power to relax:-** Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. **Saving:-** Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for Scheduled Castes, the Schedule Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the Orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Note: The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion. (Period of deputation including period of deputation in another Ex-cadre Post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization or department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.)
