New Delhi, the 15th October, 2010

G.S.R. 839(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Ministry of Home Affairs (Narcotics Control Bureau) Deputy Director/Zonal Director (Group 'A' posts) Recruitment Rules, 2008, except as respects thing done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Deputy Director/Zonal Director in the Narcotics Control Bureau, Ministry of Home Affairs, namely :—

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Home Affairs (Narcotics Control Bureau), Deputy Director/Zonal Director Recruitment Rules, 2010.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of post, classification and pay band and grade pay or pay scale.—The number of the said posts, its classification and the pay band and grade pay or pay scale attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications, etc.—The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto, shall be as specified in columns (5) to (14) of the aforesaid Schedule.

4. Disqualification.—No person,—

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts :

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax.—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on promotion. Note 2 - Period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation or department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not to exceed four years. Note 3 - The age limit for appointment by transfer on deputation shall be not exceeding fifty six years on the closing date of receipt of applications.
